- Driving Directions to Hyatt Regency New Brunswick:
 - From the New Jersey Turnpike: Take the New Jersey Turnpike to Exit 9. Proceed to Route 18 North 3 miles to Route 27 South. Travel 2 blocks to Nielson Street. Turn Left. Hotel is on the Left.
 - From Route 1: From Route 1 North or South Take Route 18 North Exit. Proceed to Route 18 North 3 miles to Route 27 South. Travel 2 blocks to Nielson Street. Turn Left. Hotel is on the Left.
- Train Information
 - The Hyatt is a 3 block walk from the New Brunswick train station, which is serviced by the Northeast Corridor Line on NJ Transit and Amtrak.
