COAH FORUM: *The Status of Third Round Compliance*

The New Jersey Chapter of the American Planning Association (NJAPA) and the Center for Government Services (CGS) are hosting a timely forum with the Council on Affordable Housing (COAH) to update the state's professional planning community on the status of municipal affordable housing programs and compliance issues in the wake of recent legal action.

A recent New Jersey appeals court decision on COAH's Third Round Regulations and the subsequent appeals have created uncertainty about the status of Third Round Affordable Housing Plans and implementation mechanism.

The COAH forum will be a unique opportunity for housing planners and others engaged in Third Round COAH compliance to hear advisory guidance in this period of uncertainty. COAH officials will also respond to concerns and questions of the NJAPA membership as efforts continue to implement COAH's Third Round Affordable Housing Program.

COAH Director Lucy Voorhoeve and her staff and several distinguished NJAPA members with expertise in affordable housing matters will serve on a panel to assist with the articulation of questions and concerns. Vito Gallo, the Chair of the NJAPA Housing Committee, will moderate the event.

There is no cost for this event, which is being offered as a professional development service to NJ/APA members and CGS invitees.
